

- Get engaged!
- Buy the groom's ring
- Announce your engagement and set a date
- Figure out a budget & who will pay for what with both families
- Choose a photographer for your engagement pictures, bridals, and wedding--Click [HERE](#) for some possibilities
- Pick your ceremony site, reception site, and officiate; book them ASAP--some places fill up months in advance!--Click [HERE](#) for some possibilities
- Pick colors & start thinking about decorations: backdrops, aisle markers, florals, etc.--Click [HERE](#) to view Brides, Etc. Rentals
- Figure out a guest list, then cut it down to your desired number & get addresses; assume 20% won't make it, or include RSVPs for a better number
- Find the perfect dress at Brides, Etc.--order it as early as possible to make sure you can get the one you want
- Find accessories, shoes, and jewelry to go along with your dress
- Order dresses for bridesmaids, flower girls, and mothers early, too, to avoid rush shipping charges
- Have a fitting & get any needed alterations (make sure you're the size you plan to be at the wedding, and don't forget to bring your shoes!)
- Get announcement pictures taken & order wedding invitations (remember RSVP cards, thank you's, & envelopes!--Click [HERE](#) for possible printers
- Start compiling pictures & music for a wedding video if you want one--Click [HERE](#) for possible vendors
- Hire a florist or buy flowers for bouquets, corsages, boutennieres, and decorations--Click [HERE](#) for local florists
- Enroll in wedding registries--make sure people from out of town have access, too--Click [HERE](#) for some ideas on where to register
- Order your wedding cake--Click [HERE](#) for local bakers/bakeries
- Order tuxedos for the groom, grooms men, ring bearer, etc.--make sure they can all come in to be measured at least a week ahead
- Figure out food & cutlery for the event (luncheon, rehearsal dinner, reception, etc)--Do it yourself or click [HERE](#) for possible caterers
- Mail your invitations four weeks before your wedding day--"Save the Date" reminders even earlier if you want them
- Arrange for hotel room blocks or reservations for out-of-town guests
- Figure out your honeymoon--get passports, visas, and reservations where needed (remember passports can take six weeks to get!)
- Make hair, nail, makeup, & massage appointments for the big day--Click [HERE](#) for local salons
- Arrange for music for the ceremony, reception, and dance if you want it--Click [HERE](#) for ideas
- Submit wedding announcement to the newspapers two weeks in advance--Click [HERE](#) for contact information
- Decide on book attendants, servers, & clean-up crews, or any other helpers you might need that day; arrange for vendors or friends to help set up
- Practice with your hair (don't forget the veil!), make-up, and nails
- Get bridal pictures and groom pictures taken to have them ready for display at the wedding
- Choose & purchase gifts for your fiance, wedding party, and helpers
- Confirm details with ALL your vendors to make sure everything is ready a few days in advance
- Go to the County Clerk's Office to get your marriage license at least 24 hours in advance--Click [HERE](#) for local information
- Assign a friend to be your "eyes and brain" for the big day, since you'll probably forget something & need a little extra help!
- Pack an essentials bag to have handy for quick fixes and touch-ups (lip gloss, makeup, tissues, eye drops, hair spray, gum, etc)
- Pamper yourself then SLEEP the night before so you're well-rested and glowing for your big day
- Make sure you plan plenty of time to get ready--go to your hair and make-up appointments with your veil, jewelry, etc.
- Relax & ENJOY! This is your day! Congratulations and best wishes from Bride's Etc!
